A. Name of Project: Statewide Public Fishing Access Sites – Silver Creek

B. Project Leader: Ivol Sies

C. Type of Work:

Channels

a. Development: a new diversion headgate was fabricated out of two inch planking and installed in the Gillihan ditch. The ditch was reinforced with earth at the site of installation.

5. Roads

a. Development: Approximately three-fourths mile of roadway was slightly graded for access to Silver Creek. Approximately one-eigth mile of this road received a light application of gravel obtained from the project area.

7. Fence

a. Development: a survey was made to accurately locate the boundary of the property. Approximately three-fourths mile of existing fence was replaced and now coincides with the surveyed boundary line. The remaining three-fourths mile of existing fence was repair as necessary to protect the area against domestic livestock use.

Two prefabricated metal cattleguards were installed for convenient access to the stream. A used galvanized pipe (20"x10") was installed under one of the cattleguards to bypass waste water from Gillihan ditch into Silver Creek. Both guards were offset approximately 14 feet to permit convenient turning from The existing lane. Also, a used 12" galvanized culvert was installed across the access road to bypass waste water flowing underneath the Gillihan ditch into Silver Creek.

8. Public Use Facilites

a. Development: Three single unit toilets, prefabricated at the Department warehouse, were installed on the project area. Also, three 50-gallon, painted barrels were placed on the area to collect waste material. A pit for disposing of cans and burnable material was due to a depth of four feet on the project area.

a. Development: A marine plywood painted sign was installed to identify the area.		
All development work was completed by July 12, 1962.
