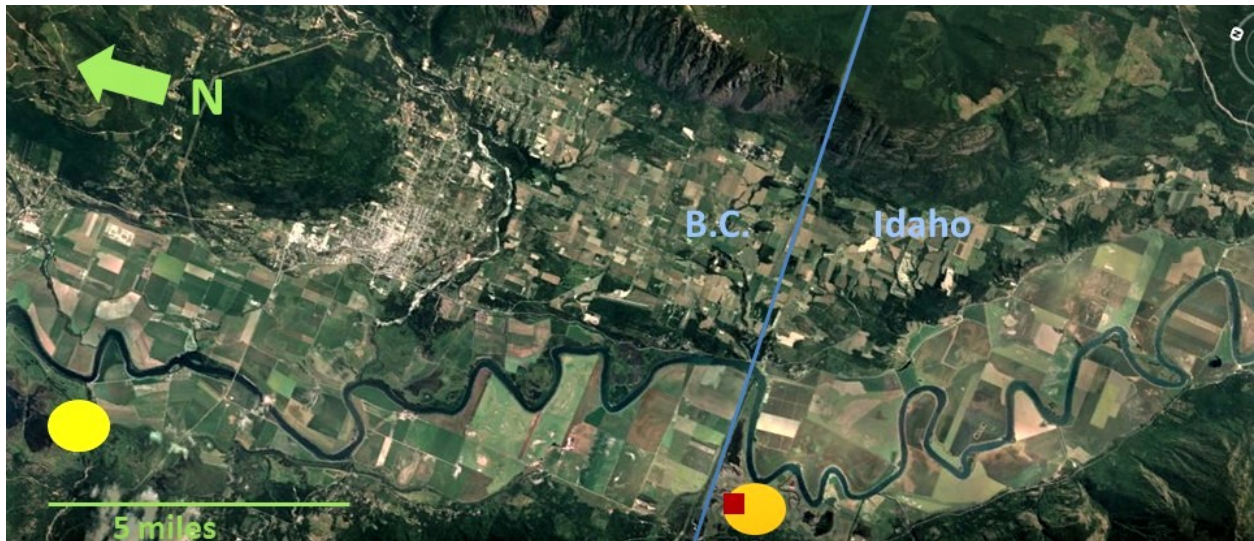

**5. If the work in this grant was part of a larger undertaking with other components and funding, present a brief overview of the larger activity and the role of this project.**

This project is part of a larger undertaking. The deliverables will contribute to the larger bullfrog control portion of the Competitive State Wildlife Grant (CSWG): *Advancing Northern Leopard Frog Recovery in Washington, Idaho, and British Columbia through Reintroduction and Habitat Management* (F18AP00947).

A portion of the CSWG is devoted to hiring a trans-boundary bullfrog coordinator to design and implement a bullfrog management program in the Creston/Kootenai Valley which spans the Idaho/British Columbia border. The purpose of the grant which this report addresses (F18AP00483) is to purchase equipment for the larger project—primarily a fisheries electro-shocker. This is important because a full set of gear on both sides of the international border will help speed border crossings and make work more efficient.

**6. Describe how the objectives were met.**

We conducted one bullfrog removal event on August 29, 2019. The event occurred at a site on Boundary-Smith Creek Wildlife Management Area. Ten adult bullfrogs were removed during the event.

We have completed the objective and there are no differences between work anticipated and work completed.


